## PETITION FOR ACCESSIBLE PUBLIC TRANSPORTS

Would you like public transports in Victoria to be fully accessible for everyone, including people with a disability, parents with prams, elderly people and anyone with temporary and permanent mobility restrictions.

Let's start with Sydney Rd where between Brunswick Road and Bakers Road, Coburg North - a 5.5km stretch, we have no accessible tram stops.

Once the Upfield train line is closed to remove the Brunswick level crossings and build Skyrail, there will be NO accessible public transport along the Upfield corridor for at least 18 months.

Under federal legislation, public transport in all states and territories was required to be fully accessible by the end of 2022. At the current rate of progress public transport in Victoria will not be fully accessible until at least 2066 - 44 years away!

Please sign our petition to the Victorian parliament to get accessible tram stops before the level crossings are removed and skyrail is built by choosing the options below.
